### Truth (Luke 17:11-19)

One day, Jesus was traveling to Jerusalem, between Samaria and Galilee. As Jesus entered a village, He saw ten men who had a skin disease, which made them live outside of the city. The men saw Jesus, and they called out: "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us." Jesus replied "Go and show yourselves to the priests," and as they went, they were healed because of their faith. They were sick and suddenly they weren't! But one on them- the Samaritan- went back to thank Jesus and praise him for what he had done. Jesus said "Were not ten cleansed? Where are the nine? No one else returned to give praise to God except the Samaritan?" And he said to the man, "Rise and go on your way; your faith has made you well."

### Equipping (Discussion questions)

1. Why did the lepers beg Christ to heal them? Because as Lepers they had to stay outside of the city and live a lonely life. It was a sad way to live.
2. Why did Jesus send them to the priest? Because they could enter back into the city if the priest said they were healed.
3. What did Jesus say made the Samaritan "well"? His faith made him well! It saved him from his illness
4. Why did Jesus ask where the other 9 were? Jesus healed them! This act deserves praise and thanksgiving!
5. How does this story remind us of the gospel? Jesus cleanses us from our sin and makes us well!

### Accountability

1. Why do we sometimes forget to say thank you?
2. Sometimes we should thank you even when we don't feel like it. Why do you think that is?
3. Is it enough to just feel grateful? Or should we use our words and actions to say thank you?
