Truth (Read Matthew 21:1-11)

Now when they drew near to Jerusalem and came to Bethphage, to the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples, saying to them, "Go into the village in front of you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied, and a colt with her. Untie them and bring them to me. If anyone says anything to you, you shall say, 'The Lord needs them,' and he will send them at once." This took place to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet, saying,

"Say to the daughter of Zion,
'Behold, your king is coming to you,
humble, and mounted on a donkey,
on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden.'"

The disciples went and did as Jesus had directed them. They brought the donkey and the colt and put on them their cloaks, and he sat on them. Most of the crowd spread their cloaks on the road, and others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road. And the crowds that went before him and that followed him were shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!" And when he entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred up, saying, "Who is this?" And the crowds said, "This is the prophet Jesus, from Nazareth of Galilee."

Equipping (Discussion Questions)

1. **Why were the people celebrating?** Because their savior had come!
2. **What were the crowds doing when they saw Jesus?** They put their coats down and said, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!"
3. **What does Hosanna mean?** It means 'save now!'
4. **In what way was Jesus going to save them?** He would save them from the consequences of their sins, which was not what they expected. But this was their greatest need.

Accountability

1. How would you feel if God did not fulfill something you had been waiting for in the way you wanted?
2. How can you keep in mind that God is still working while you're waiting for something big to happen?
3. Is there something you are waiting for that you're not trusting God with?

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Mission


1. What are some ways God has helped you be patient with your friends and family?
