**DID YOU KNOW?** Moses wrote the book of Deuteronomy which means “second law.” Before the Israelites entered the Promised Land, God once again reminded his people that he was their God, he had led them out of slavery in Egypt and he had called them to obey his law. In Deuteronomy he gives his people the Ten Commandments for a second time (the first is recorded in Exodus 20).

**WHAT DOES IT MEAN?** God’s people were finally going to get to live in Canaan, the land that God had promised to Abraham, but the people living there worshiped many gods. In Deuteronomy, God reminded his people of his laws, the way he wanted them to live, especially the First Commandment that said Israel could have no other gods, only Jehovah. Moses told them again that Jehovah alone is God and they should love him most and keep his commandments on their hearts. Because of Jesus we can love God most too and memorizing his Word, the Bible, is a great way to keep God’s commands on our hearts.
