Family Discipleship Devotional (To Be Led by Parent)

Truth (Read Colossians 3:15)

"And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful."

Equipping (Discussion questions)

1. Who brings us peace? Christ does!
2. What is the peace of Christ? The calmness which comes from trusting in Christ!
3. What does it mean "you were called in one body"? We are called to work together and live in community!
4. How can the peace from God help you live in peace with others?
5. Why is it important for us to live in peace with others?

Accountability

1. Have you leaned more on the side of thankful or disappointed recently?
2. Who have you been living in peace with lately? Who have you not been living in peace with?
3. What is making it hard right now to live in peace with others? What is something you can do to take steps toward living in peace with others?
4. Is there a situation that you are struggling to find peace with that you need to give to God?

Mission

1. Who do you want to share the peace of Christ with?
2. How can remembering to be thankful to God help show peace to others?

Supplication

1. Let's pray for that hard situation!

"God, Thank you so much for your peace, for showing us how much you care for us by sending Jesus so we can be with you now and forever. God, we know there are times when it's difficult for us to live in peace with others. There are people in our lives who frustrate us or annoy us. Help us to show peace, especially to (Pause and prompt kids to silently fill in the name or situation they need to give to God). God, we know that you will help us make peace with the people we just thought of. In Jesus' name, we pray. Amen."
