Truth (Read 1 John 1:9)

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

Equipping (Discussion questions)

1. What does John tell us about God in this verse? He is faithful, He forgives, He makes us pure, and He is fair
2. What does it mean to confess our sins? admit when we've done something wrong against God
3. What does it mean that God is faithful? always there, never lies, trustworthy
4. How do we receive forgiveness for our sins? We have to confess our sins to God but the reason we can do this is Jesus! Because Jesus died for us and covers our sin!

Accountability

1. Do you have a hard time confessing sin to God? Is it something you do every day?
2. How does this verse make you feel about confessing?
3. Do you ever try to hide your sin from God?
4. Do you have any sin in mind you should confess?

Mission

Part of being a follower of Jesus is obeying his call to share the gospel with others in what we say and how we act. Another part of being a follower of Jesus is admitting we are totally sinful and need his forgiveness.

People we want to share the gospel with might not believe they are sinful. In fact, they might think they are pretty good! But knowing we are sinful is an important step in accepting the forgiveness God gives us.

What can we do to show our friends and family their need for Jesus's forgiveness? Share passages from God's word with them that talk about our sin, pray that God's spirit will open up their eyes

Supplication

Follow the ACTS (adoration, confession, thanksgiving, and supplication) acronym in prayer today:

Adoration (A)- Praise God for who He is

God, we know you are loving and just to your people...

Confession (C)- Confess any sin that is on your heart.

Lord, we confess that we have sinned by...

Note: Make sure to model confession! It's important that your kids see you confess and repent so they can follow along

Thanksgiving (T)- Thank God for who is he and for forgiving your sin!

Thank you God this day and for sending your son so we could be forgiven of...

Supplication (S)- This is where your prayer requests go!

Lord, Will you help us be more patient with our classmates...
