### Truth (Read Ephesians 4:29)

### Equipping (Discussion questions)

1. What is corrupting talk? Anything that would not build up others
2. What is an example of words that would build up others? Encouraging someone, complimenting someone, or even telling them about God!
3. What is the point of this verse? We should use our words wisely and build each other up.
4. Who gives us the perfect example of using words of hope, truth, and love? Jesus!

### Accountability

1. How has your speech been towards others?
2. Would you say you have been more negative or positive recently?
3. Is there anyone you need to apologize to for how you have been speaking to them?

### Mission

1. Who is someone that could use some encouragement?
2. How does speaking in a positive way help share the joy of Christ?

### Supplication

1. Do you have any prayer requests?
2. Are there any sins this devotional brought to mind that you want to pray about?
