WHAT YOU NEED: "Umbrella Verse" Activity Page, cardstock, blue tissue paper torn or cut into small pieces, crayons


DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage children to color the umbrella and make raindrops on their paper using blue tissue paper.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "When do you use an umbrella? (*Pause.*) Most of the times you use an umbrella when it's raining. Sometimes you use it when it's sunny outside. God is with you when it's sunny or raining, God is with you wherever you go."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "God is with you wherever you go. That's our Memory Verse, and it's written on the umbrella on your paper. Let's add some raindrops on your paper using this tissue paper.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Let's say our memory verse together. God is with you wherever you go, Joshua 1:9. Great! One more time: God is with you wherever you go, Joshua 1:9. No matter where you go, God's got it. Who's got it? God's got it."
