Romans 8:31-39

- ³¹ What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who is against us?
- ³² He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him over for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?
- ³³ Who will bring a charge against God's elect? God is the one who justifies;
- ³⁴ who is the one who condemns? Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, rather who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who also intercedes for us.
- ³⁵ Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?
- ³⁶ Just as it is written, "FOR YOUR SAKE WE ARE BEING PUT TO DEATH ALL DAY LONG; WE WERE CONSIDERED AS SHEEP TO BE SLAUGHTERED."
- ³⁷ But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us.
- ³⁸ For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers,
- ³⁹ nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 8:33

- ³³ Who will bring a charge against God's elect? God is the one who justifies;
- 1) "God's elect"
- 2) "It is God who justifies"
 - a. Man's relationship with God is a legal one.
 - b. God Himself has constructed the Law which governs His relationship with man.
 - c. God not only is the Law Maker and its administrator; He is also The Judge.
 - d. Any charge brought against man must be brought in terms of the Law and nothing else.

Romans 3:24, 26b
