⁴ and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures,

⁵ and that He appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve.

⁶ After that He appeared to more than five hundred brethren at one time, most of whom remain until now, but some have fallen asleep;

⁷ then He appeared to James, then to all the apostles;

⁸ and last of all, as to one untimely born, He appeared to me also.

About this time there lived Jesus, a wise man [if indeed one ought to call him a <u>man.</u>] For he was one who wrought surprising feats and was a teacher of such people as accept the truth gladly. He won over many Jews and many of the Greeks. [He was the Christ.] When Pilate, upon hearing him accused by men of the highest standing amongst us, had condemned him to be crucified, those who had in the first place come to love him did not give up their affection for him. [On the third day he appeared to them restored to life, for the prophets of God had prophesied these and countless other marvelous things about him.] And the tribe of the Christians, so called after him, has still to this day not disappeared.

Gauged by the consequences which have followed, the birth, life and resurrection of Jesus have been most important events in the history of man. Measured by His influence, Jesus is central in the human story."

Religions & Their Leaders

- 1. Confucianism (Confucius)
 - o From China
 - 551 B.C. 479 B.C.
 - \circ Largest following at one time = 300 million
 - o Only 6 million now
- 2. Buddhism (Buddha)
 - o Siddhartha Guantama
 - \circ From India
 - 563 B.C. 483 B.C.
 - \circ 360 million followers
- 3. Islam (Mohammad)
 - o 570 A.D.
 - \circ 1.2 billion followers
- 4. Hinduism (No single leader)o 1.5 billion followers
- 5. Christianity (Jesus) o 2 billion followers

Areas Of Contrast

- 1. Teaching
 - \circ Confucius
 - "Analects"
 - Wisdom editor only
 - o Buddha
 - Four Noble Truths (took from Hinduism)
 - First writing 400 years later (oral tradition)

- o Mohammad
 - Koran
- o Jesus
 - Old Testament & New Testament Of The Bible

- 2. Moral Life
 - \circ Confucius
 - OK but not perfect
 - \circ Buddha
 - OK but not perfect
 - o Mohammad
 - Many moral struggles
 - Violated his own teaching (exceeding # of wives)
 - Changed his own teaching mid stream
 - \circ Jesus
 - Perfect
- 3. Miracles
 - \circ Confucius none
 - \circ Buddha none
 - \circ Mohammad none
 - \circ Jesus many
 - Not "if", but "how"
- 4. Prophetic Power
 - $\circ~$ Confucius none
 - o Buddha none
 - $\circ~$ Mohammad few
 - o Jesus constantly
- 5. Present Status
 - o Only Jesus claimed to be alive/overcoming death
