- 2. Everyone has a sufficient opportunity to know about God.
  - Yes, though not the same opportunity, but never the less, a sufficient opportunity
  - What are all people guilty of?
    - Not of rejecting Jesus
  - If guilty of neglecting Jesus
  - Why the Great Commission
  - God would be unjust for not sending His son and would make salvation no longer a gift of God's grace
  - "No one will be judged for not obeying revelation they did not have."
     John Piper
  - Man innately knows there is a God (Romans 1)
    - Ecclesiastes 3:11 "God has set eternity in their (man's) heart."
  - Man is guilty of rejecting God, not Jesus (Romans 1:18)
  - Those who desire God will be given an understanding of Him.
    - Story of Cornelius (Acts 10)
    - Dreams and visions in Muslim countries
  - Not treating people the same is not being unfair (Matthew 20 parable)
- 3. God does not deal only with individuals.
  - Westerners = Individualistic
  - Easterners (Biblical days) = Corporate personality
  - Story of Achan (Joshua 7)
  - We tend to dislike corporate personality, yet it is one of mankind's greatest gifts
    - Play out scenario with and without corporate personality (1st Adam and 2nd Adam)
- 4. God would not be righteous if sinful people were not punished.
  - To not punish sinful men would require God to lie
